Participation in the Wisconsin FFA Alumni Association, Inc. council is subject to the observance of the organizations rules and procedures. **Because we represent the Wisconsin FFA Alumni Association, Inc. the following activities will be strictly prohibited.** Any Executive Officer or Sectional Representative who violates this Code of Conduct is subject to disciplinary action, including up to removal from office.

- Abusive language towards other council members or representatives of the FFA Family (Wisconsin Association of Agricultural Educators, FFA Center, FFA Foundation and Department of Public Instruction)
- Possession or use of illegal drugs before reporting to or during an official council meeting or affiliate meeting.
- Bringing to a council meeting or affiliate meeting any dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons or other similar items.
- Discourtesy or rudeness, or verbal, physical, visual, sexual, or any harassment to fellow council members, affiliate members, or FFA Family members.
- Actual or threatening violence toward any council members or group.
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
- Failure to follow Wisconsin Alumni Bylaws or Procedures.
- Participating in any activity that harms the organization.
