

Wisconsin FFA Alumni Chapter Support Grant

Aim & Purpose:

The purpose of the FFA Alumni Support Grant is to provide financial assistance to established Wisconsin FFA Alumni chapters. This grant will aid a struggling FFA Alumni Chapter in supporting and/or promoting agricultural education in its community. The applying FFA Alumni Chapter must provide an identifiable purpose for the grant that is in align with the purpose of an FFA Alumni.

Grants will be in the amount of \$550 per FFA Alumni Chapter.

Criteria:

- The FFA Alumni Chapter must provide a written statement showing it is suffering from a hardship in either membership or finances.
- An FFA Alumni Chapter can only receive this grant every other year.
- The applying FFA Alumni Chapter must have submitted all required membership paperwork to the Executive Director of the Wisconsin FFA Alumni Association along with all paid state and national dues.
- Affiliate must POSTMARK the grant application by no later than November 1. All applications need to be sent to the Wisconsin FFA Alumni Association, W2680 US Hwy 10, Granton, WI 54436.
- A third party will evaluate the grant application and make recommendations to the membership committee.
- The grant will be awarded at the Annual Wisconsin FFA Alumni Convention.
- The FFA Alumni Chapter cannot receive the New Affiliate Grant and the Support Grant in the same year.

Follow-up Criteria:

- The FFA Alumni Chapter must submit the Follow-up Grant Review. The Follow-up Grant Review must be sent to the Wisconsin FFA Alumni Association, W2680 US Hwy 10, Granton, WI 54436 no later than two months after affiliate's project is complete.
- The Wisconsin FFA Alumni suggests that the FFA Alumni Chapter creates a display to be used at the following year's State FFA Alumni Convention to highlight the successes of the affiliate due to receiving the grant.

Availability of this grant is subject to approval by the: Membership Committee and the State FFA Alumni Council and based on the Wisconsin FFA Alumni Association budget.
