MEMBERSHIP AND RECRUITMENT

- Dinner for new FFA members and parents (free)

- Give talks at high school.
- Christmas Party.
- Parents night w/ FFA parents and Alumni
- We have an Appreciation Dinner for all members 1x/ year and invite perspective new members.

- Ask potential member to participate in on of your activities. Get them some “hands on experience” and recognize their ability to contribute.
- Contact former FFA members, send invitations to parents of current FFA members.
- Help out a neighboring affiliate with their functions.
- Encourage scholarship winner to “repay” support with participation in alumni activities.
- Don’t wait, ASK local business to join. Form a committee to work on membership, not just one person.
- Good food and fun, Sept. cook-out w/ softball game. Everyone is invited FFA members and adults.
- We have good luck in recruiting new people by showing them we support the young people. We have fun doing it; it isn’t that much work.
- We sponsor a meal and invite businesses and FFA member parents. Tell them about FFA Alumni events and activities.
- Alumni affiliate could pay FFA member dues for 5 hours work.
- Have breakfast meetings, provide breakfast for prospect
- We give FFA graduates a 1 year membership or equivalent to lifetime membership.
- Only students with Alumni parents are eligible for scholarships.
- Alumni or FFA chapter pays dues for parents of officer team
- Don’t forget to say THANK YOU to others!

FUNDRAISING

- Setup food stand at local farm and household auctions. Machine sheds make great locations for food stands on cold days.
- Golf outing Fundraiser
- Food Stand owned cheese curds, cream puffs etc.
- Farm toy show, bolt and filter sale, fruit sale.
- Our student skill and consignment sale is held each spring. ½ of proceeds goes to individual students. Profits fund scholarships.
- Tractor pulls, old Tractor pulls, old tractors make money on concessions.
- Booth at County Fair, Scholarships, hog raffle, polka dance, tool sale
- Sport Show. We work with MC Sports of Madison. We buy about 15 guns, split them into three tables and at least 4 on the main ticket. We sell only 140 tickets at \$40 each. That includes dinner and other prizes. We buy other items for the tables and sell tickets for \$10 or 3 for \$20. Guns are returned to shop and winners get gift certificate at store for value of gun.
- Euchre card party \$15 per couple with door prizes
- Host snowmobile races
- Hold a live attraction at your local golf course after a golf league night.

OTHER IDEAS

- Invite other area affiliates to your meetings and activities to share and learn.
- Help coordinate and chaperone Food For America activities.
- We helped the FFA chapter start a "Holiday Cheer" campaign for U.S. Troops stationed overseas during the holidays.
- Flyer on NASCAR racing.
- Success Breeds more success. People want to be part of a winner. Strive to have your Alumni be recognized as the community organization that gets things done.
- Have a horse drawn float in the Christmas Parade with the FFA members riding wagon.
- Train your main officers, main teachers well and support them.
